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## South Tyrol DOC Riesling

Brought to South Tyrol in the 19th century by Archduke John of Austria, Riesling wines are some of the most elegant and refined whites. In contrast to its German forebears, Riesling is here thoroughly fermented and usually matured without or with only very little residual sugar.

<b>Grape variety:</b>	Riesling
<b>Cultivating area:</b>	Slopes above Bolzano and the Valle Isarco, 500 m a.s.l.(1640 ft)
<b>Harvest date:</b>	early to mid-October
<b>Vinification:</b>	Gentle pressing and fermentation in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature. Maturation is also in stainless steel to ensure the freshness of the wine.
<b>Tasting notes:</b>	<b>Color:</b> greenish to pale yellow <b>Aroma:</b> fruity scent of peach and apricots, delicately floral, slightly ethereal <b>Flavor:</b> dry, elegant, fresh with a pleasant acidity, lively
<b>Alcohol:</b>	13* %vol
<b>Residual sugar:</b>	3,5* g/l
<b>Serving temperature:</b>	10-12 °C (50 – 54 °F)
<b>Food pairing:</b>	Fish and shellfish, poultry, goat's cheese and vegetarian dishes
